- By Train  
— King Street Wharf is a 7 minute walk from Wynyard train station or an 8 minute walk from Pymont light rail station.

Secure Parking offer two great parking stations close to King Street Wharf.  
— King Street Wharf Parking on Shelley Street is the closest parking available.  
— Another nearby parking station is 321 Kent Street with an approximate five minute walk to King Street Wharf.

## Check-in requirements

If you are making your own way to the boarding terminal, please arrive at the ticket office 30 minutes prior to the departure time to exchange for ticket/boarding pass before proceeding to the boarding terminal. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely

be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

- Vessels

There are two authentic paddlewheelers operate on regular nightly Sydney Showboat Dinner Cruise. Your reservation on the night, will be allocated to either of these two vessels at the company's discretion. Your group will be allocated individual reserved tables.

- Child Onboard

— Children under the age of 16, cruising on our vessels, must always be under the supervision of their accompanying adults at all times. Under no circumstances, should children be allowed to run around inside the vessel or on the outer decks or lean over balustrades. It is the obligation of the parents/guardians to uphold the safety of the children cruising with them. It is extremely important for parents/guardians to ensure that their guests below the age of 16 are always well behaved, so as not to impact the enjoyment of any other guests onboard.

— Please note that whilst Service Provider is delighted to welcome well-behaved children on board the vessels/cruising restaurants, Service Provider does not provide high chairs due to safety reasons.
