How to get there

- By Car
Located approximately 17km south of Margaret River, takes about 15 minutes; approximately 70km south of Busselton Visitor Centre, takes about 1 hour; approximately 296km south of Perth, takes about 3 hour 20 minutes.

Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive at the meeting point /departure point 10 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Lake Cave Single Cave Entry

Lake Cave is a stunning pristine chamber deep beneath the earth. Inside the cave a tranquil lake mirrors the delicate crystal formations on the roof above, providing reflections that are simply breathtaking.

The only cave in the Leeuwin-Naturaliste Ridge that has a permanent lake; visitors to Lake Cave marvel at the unique 'Suspended Table' formation, which weighs several tonnes and seems to defy gravity as it hovers above the clear water.

Access to the cave is through a spectacular doline (sink hole). Visitors descend a 'staircase in time', to then gaze up at the towering karri trees from the floor of the sunken forest.

During a guided tour you'll see delicate crystal decorations reflected in the water of the lake - many of the crystals are 'dripping' which shows that they continue to grow. While seated at the back of the chamber, you can enjoy the unique 'underground ambience' of the cave with the sound of these droplets falling to the lake. The guide will change the feature lighting within the cavern to provide unique views of the cave features and formations.
