 - Broadbeach: meet in the car park beside the Kurrawa Surf Life Saving Club (Address: Old Burleigh Rd, Broadbeach QLD 4218)
 - Surfers Paradise: Go Ride A Wave Surfers Paradise shop (Address: Paradise Centre, 189/8-10 Cavill Ave, Surfers Paradise QLD 4217)

How to get there

- By Car
 - Kirra Point
Kirra is a famous surfing location at the Southern end of the Gold Coast. It is just around the point from Coolangatta and close to Coolangatta Airport. Turn off the Gold Coast Highway towards Coolangatta and you will get to Kirra just before you arrive at Coolangatta.
 - Broadbeach
Driving along the Gold Coast Highway, turn towards the beach at the intersection between the Jupiters Casino and Pacific Fair Shopping Centre. This is Margaret Avenue and when come to the T intersection should turn left towards the Kurrawa Surf Club and find a car park nearby. Head to the big white van in the car park beside the surf club to meet the instructor.
 - Surfers Paradise
Only 60 minutes' drive south from Brisbane CBD and 45 minutes north of Byron Bay. Will easily find Surfers Paradise learn to surf shop opposite the famous Surfers Paradise Sign at the beach end of Cavill Mall.

Check-in requirements

- Kids prices apply to customers 17 years and under on the day of the class.

- Recommend 8 years old and above for the normal daily lessons because 2 hours is a long time for younger kids.

- Please lock personal items in the trailer while surfing.

- Package classes must be taken within one calendar year of the date of the first class.
