

The name Nitmiluk, meaning 'Cicada Place', came from the Jawoyn people who are the traditional custodians of the Park.

#### Katherine Gorge

A must-see of the Top End is Katherine Gorge, situated just 30 kilometres north-east of Katherine nestled in the heart of Nitmiluk National Park. Katherine is the Top End's third largest town with a pioneering history dating back to the 1860s, it is settled along the banks of the Katherine River, 320 kilometres south-east of Darwin.

Initially named by explorer John McDouall Stuart in the late 1800s after the daughter of an expedition sponsor, the area was later renamed 'Nitmiluk' in 1989 translating to 'cicada place' when traditional owners of the land, the Jawoyn Aboriginal people, gained title to the land.

#### Highlights

- Travel along Australia's longest highway, the Stuart, on your way into Nitmiluk National Park and Katherine Gorge
- Stop at the Adelaide River War Cemetery, dedicated to those who lost their lives in the north of Australia during WWII
- Enter Nitmiluk National Park, with its rugged landscapes, thundering waterfalls, and diverse flora and fauna
- · Visit Leliyn (Edith Falls), where during the dry season you can take a refreshing swim in the waterhole beneath the falls
- Throughout Nitmiluk you'll see Aboriginal rock art that expresses in images the deep spiritual culture of the Jawoyn people, traditional owners of this land
- · Enjoy lunch in a shaded outdoor setting
- Browse through the Nitmiluk Visitor Centre and see photographs, memorabilia and traditional Aboriginal artefacts
- On your two-hour cruise through the 70-metre-high sandstone walls of Katherine Gorge, keep your eyes peeled for freshwater crocodiles, wonderful birdlife and amazing scenery
