## How to get there

- By Car  
Located approximately 45km north of Coffs Harbour, takes about 40 minutes.  
- From Coffs Harbour: follow Pacific Hwy/A1 to Eggins Dr in Woolgoolga. Follow Eggins Dr, Pacific Hwy/A1 and turn right onto Coral St. Turn left onto Red Rock Rd and turn left onto Ford Street. After approximately 300m turn right and head towards the creek and boat ramp. The tour will be launch at Red Rock Boat Ramp.
- By Coach  
If you do not drive, complimentary transfer from/to selected hotels included. Please indicate the name of your hotel at the point of booking - the most convenient pick-up location and time will be advised in your booking confirmation.

# Coffs Harbour Moonee Creek Premium Cultural Stand Up Paddling

Stand up paddle with the direct descendants of the world's first stand up paddlers and connect to land and sea through language and stories, and collect and taste seasonal bush food.

The tours take place on the homelands of the Gumbaynggirr tribal nation and all of the guides are Gumbaynggirr people or Aboriginal people who have strong family ties to Gumbaynggirr country.

In Gumbaynggirr language, Munim Munim translates to 'rocky'. Paddle from the bush to the beach in this pristine marine park waterway in order to follow the Gumbaynggirr Dreaming songline track (traditional stories that are written in and told by the landscape) of how the ocean was created. Along the Dreaming track participants engage in Gumbaynggirr language and sample seasonal bush foods.

You will also receive a small gift to take home.

## LOCATION

Moonee Beach is located 10km north of Coffs Harbour (approximately 10 minutes drive).

Coffs Harbour is located on the north coast of NSW approximately half way between Sydney and Brisbane (6-7 hours drive north of Sydney or 1 hour flight).

## FEATURES

- Learn how the language, Gumbaynggirr came to be in the Dreaming and learn simple Gumbaynggirr phrases
- Follow and engage with a traditional Gumbaynggirr Dreaming story
- Sample bush food delicacies, such as lemon myrtle, yams, pig face (barridamam), honey suckle banksia (maawa), native sarsparella, paper bark tree (balawungga)
- Engage with the resilience of Gumbaynggirr culture and learn how our culture has been preserved over time

## • POLICY •
