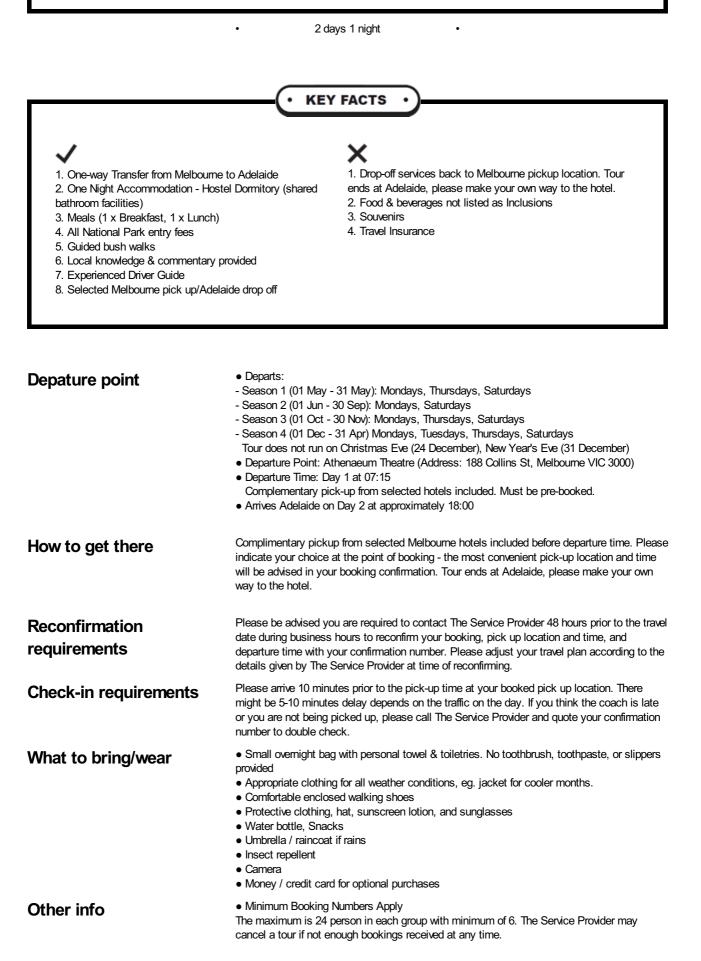
2 Day Great Ocean Road and Grampians Tour: Departs from Melbourne Finishes in Adelaide with Hostel Dormitory
