Departure point

How to get there

Complimentary transfer from/to selected pick up locations included. Please advise your choice of pick up location at the point of booking and make your own way to that location for pick up on the travel date.

Check-in requirements

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.

- Tour
 - Please bring a windbreaker and walking shoes.
 - Price based on two people sharing a room.
- Children
 - Children aged 3 years and under are free if not occupying a seat (*must sit in parent's/carer's lap). If a seat is required, surcharge or child fare applies.
 - Children aged 4 years and up to 14 years receive 50% discount off Adult fare unless otherwise stated.
 - Adult fares apply to persons 15 years and over.
 - Infants travelling on a Public Day Tour aged between 0-3 will be given an allocated seat and be seated in a Child Restraint Seat subject to availability.
 - Child Restraint Seats will be available for hire or the customer may supply their own.
 - Children aged 4-7 travelling on a Public Day Tour must be

seated in an allocated seat and wear a seat belt.

- Booster Seats are available as an option for hire or the customer may supply their own.
- Children aged 4-7 must not travel in the first two rows of the coach on a Public Day Tour.

- **General**

- Itineraries, prices and days of operation are subject to change or withdrawal without notice. A fuel levy may apply when world oil prices exceed the allowance in the fare.
- State and territory laws require all passengers to wear seat belts in seat belt equipped vehicles. The service provider is not responsible for monitoring this requirement.

The Great Ocean Road is one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives. Taking in not only stunning

Day 1 [Gray Line Melbourne] Two Day Tour - Great Ocean Road Overnight - Day 1

Join this regular day tour to Great Ocean Road and be dropped off in the beautiful resort town of Lorne staying overnight at Cumberland Resort with use of resort facilities. Arrive late morning with the afternoon and following morning free to relax and enjoy.

Tour Itinerary*

- See the hive of activity at Port of Melbourne, city views and the expanse of Port Phillip Bay as depart Melbourne.
- Travel Victoria's Surf Coast and its spectacular coastal views.
- Quaint beach resort of Lorne nestled between steep hills and ocean where will have a full day to explore and relax before re-joining tour the following day.
- Stay overnight at Cumberland Resort with use of resort facilities.

Day 2 [Gray Line Melbourne] Two Day Tour - Great Ocean Road Overnight - Day 2

Rejoin the coach in the late morning on the following day and continue with adventure along one of the world's greatest scenic coastal drives. Lunch stop (*own expense) is at Apollo Bay before continuing to Port Campbell National Park to explore the Twelve Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge and Island Arch. Chinese (Mandarin) or Japanese language GPS commentary options available.

Tour Itinerary*

- Inviting sandy beaches, rugged coastal cliffs, forested hills and rolling surf providing endless photo opportunities throughout the day.
- Gentle river inlets populated by rich greenery.
- Explore Apollo Bay and pick out a lunch spot (*own expense).
- Otway National Park - Australian temperate rainforest and home to towering eucalypts and lush ferns.
- Port Campbell National Park home to the Twelve Apostles and aptly named "Shipwreck Coast".
- Majesty of the Twelve Apostles.
- Optional short helicopter flight over the Twelve Apostles (*own expense).
- Tom & Eva and Razorback - carved by the powerful southern ocean.
- Site of the tragic shipwreck of the "Loch Ard" - Loch Ard Gorge.
- Port Campbell - friendly holiday resort and fishing village.
- Spectacular night skyline of Melbourne from West Gate Bridge.
