How to get there

Australian Outback Spectacular is located on Entertainment Road at Oxenford, between Warner Bros. Movie World and Wet'n'Wild Water World.

• By Car

- From Surfers Paradise: Drive along the Gold Coast Highway to Smith Street and follow the signs to Brisbane and the Pacific Motorway. Take Exit 60 to Warner Bros. Movie World and Wet'n'Wild Water World. Turn left at the traffic lights.

- From Brisbane: Follow the signs to the Pacific Motorway and the Gold Coast. Take Exit 60 to Warner Bros. Movie World and Wet'n'Wild Water World. Pass under the Motorway and turn left at the traffic lights.

- Free car parking is available at the front of the attraction.

Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive 30 minutes before the doors open to allow enough time to check in. Passengers that fail to arrive before this time may be classified as no-show.

Other info

- Show schedule subject to seasonal changes throughout the year.

- Doors to the venue open approximately one hour and 15 minutes prior to show time with pre-show entertainment commencing at the same time. Arena doors open 30 minutes prior to show time. Show duration is 1 hour and 45 minutes including a delicious three course meal.

- Please note guests will be in close proximity to livestock. Persons with allergies or asthma may be affected. Strobe lights and atmospheric effects will be used during the performance which may not be suitable for guests with a history of vertigo, epilepsy, seizures, heart disorders and high blood pressure

- Passengers under the age of 14 years old must be accompanied by an Adult (18 years or older).

- No food or drink is to be brought into the venue without prior permission

- Due to health and safety requirements, strollers, high chairs or bouncers are not permitted inside the venue. They can be stored in the Cloak Room.

- For the safety of the riders and their horses, and all the other performers in the show, video cameras and flash photography cannot be used at any time. Strobe effects and lighting are also used in the production.

[Important Post-Covid Service Information]

- Guests aged 16 years and older must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 (predicted from 17th December 2021). Upon entry all guests must show their proof of vaccination prior to entering using the Queensland Check-In App. Some guests will have a government compliant medical exemption and attractions will work with those guests regarding their specific situation. Guests aged 16 years and older, unable to provide the vaccination or medical exemption documentation will be refused entry and no refund will be offered as the consequence.

- Tickets to Australian Outback Spectacular cannot be loaded onto the Village Roadshow Theme Parks app but guests can show their confirmation email on their mobile devices when entering the venue

The Technology

- **Experience An Immersive Arena**

Australian Outback Spectacular's Heartland is visually stunning and the production completely encompasses the arena, utilising every possible space to create the vibrant and ever changing landscape of the Australian outback.

An incredibly sophisticated and advanced technical installation provides the audience a unique experience where they are transported into the outback via a high level and complex projection mapping system.

Projection mapping assists in showcasing the diversity of the Australian landscape moving from the red dust, rocky outcrops and rugged plains to the lush green fields feeling the effects of a thunderstorm consisting of clapping thunder, electric lightning and drenching rain.

The Venue

- **Iconic Red Roof**

Every aspect of the venue has been well thought out and planned to give the arena a truly unique and authentic Australian Outback look and feel.

From the fully themed landscape with great iconic Australian natives and scenic backdrops, the corrugated iron roof, galvanised railings and heavy timbers that are used throughout the arena to the old fashioned wagon wheel light fittings, and winding billabong located under the entrance bridge – the venue truly transports you to the Australian Outback.

The Food

- **Entree**

Start the night with a rustic woodfire roasted Vegetable and Goat Feta Tart served with wild rocket and home-made pineapple chutney.

- **Main**

Gather round for a hearty meal of Australian beef or farm seasoned Chicken. A juicy eye fillet steak or a tender chicken breast, both cooked to perfection are served with a full-bodied jus dressed with lashings of plum sauce accompanied by a generous serve of roast pumpkin, green beans and potato.

- **Dessert**

The drought has finally broken and it's time to celebrate with a delicate Chocolate Tart served with a delicious honey salted caramel sauce, and a pinch of chocolate dirt from the outback.
