## Departure point

- Departs: daily, all year round

- Departure Point: B Shed Victoria Quay, Fremantle
- Departure Time: 09:00 (approx.)  
Departure time is reference only and subject to availability.
- Arrives back at approximately 16:35

## How to get there

- By Car  
There are several paid parking areas in Victoria Quay, including short, medium and long term options. This parking is not undercover nor is it secure and it is in demand.  
- Parking fees apply
- By Public Transport  
The Fremantle Train Station & bus terminal is a 5 minute walk from Victoria Quay.

## Check-in requirements

Please ensure you arrive at the meeting point /departure point 30 minutes before your scheduled departure time to allow enough time to check in. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

## What to bring/wear

- Motion-sickness medicine (if required)
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable enclosed walking shoes
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle, Snacks
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains
- Insect repellent
- Camera
- Money / credit card for optional purchases

- Bicycles must be collected on the island by an Adult (18+). Bicycles must be returned to Pedal and Flipper by 17:00.

- Child Policy

- Children under 4 years of age travel free of charge provided they do not occupy a seat.
- In the interest of safety, children aged twelve or under are not permitted to travel without direct supervision from a parent or adult guardian.

- Rottnest Island Government Admission Fees

All visitors to Rottnest Island are required to pay a Government Admission Fee, or 'landing fee' which is collected from island visitors by the ferry companies on behalf of the Rottnest Island Authority. This fee contributes to the conservation of the Island, provisions and upkeep of facilities. This fee will be included in the total price of your ferry fare, and is payable at the time of booking.

- Taking Pets to Rottnest Island

- Rottnest Island has an especially unique environment and is a Class A Reserve.
- Pets are NOT allowed on the Island under any circumstances.
- Registered Guide Dogs: If there is a genuine medical requirement to bring an animal with you such as a guide, assistance or companion dog this is acceptable, however please contact the Rangers prior to arrival on (08) 9372 9788.

#### Bike Hire - discover Rottnest Island by bicycle!

Cycling is environmentally friendly and a fun recreational activity for all ages. As Rottnest Island has no private vehicles, cycling is also one of the best modes of transport on the Island. To ride around the entire island (22kms) you would need between 3-5 hours, alternatively there are shorter routes available.

SKIP THE LINE! Make your way from the ferry to the Pedal and Flipper shop behind Hotel Rottnest. You can line up at the priority queue making it quick and easy to get your bike. Your bike hire will include a helmet and lock. The Bike Hire team is trained to personally fit customers to bikes to ensure optimum comfort and safety.

Bicycles must be collected on the island by an Adult (18+). Bicycles must be returned to Pedal and Flipper by 17:00.

**09:35** – Arrive at Rottnest Island

**09:50** – Pick up bike from Pedal and Flipper Shop on the island (Enjoy free-time from 09:50 onwards)

**15:30** – Drop off bike hire at Pedal and Flipper

**16:00** – Ferry departs Rottnest Island

**16:35** – Ferry arrives B Shed Fremantle
