【Important Post-Covid Service Information】

- Prior to travelling, you will be required to provide a current phone number and residential address (address of accommodation if travelling) and your full name in order to complete your activity.
- You will be visiting Flynn and Milln Reefs therefore will not be able to offer the Glass Bottom Boat Tour. Introductory, Certified Diving and Guided Snorkel Tours will all be available. Lunch will be a pre-packaged boxed lunch for the first week of operation.

- Guided Snorkel Experience is suitable for beginner snorkellers.
- All diving is subject to completion of an onboard medical questionnaire. Certain medical conditions, (I.e. asthma, epilepsy, high blood pressure) or medications may exclude individuals from diving.
- The legal minimum age for diving is 12 years.
- After diving, intervals of 12-24 hours are recommended prior to flying depending on depths of dives and accrued dive time.
- No refund given on diving.
