## How to get there

Return transfer from/to Hervey Bay Airport included. Please indicate the flight details at the point of booking - the most convenient pick-up location and time will be advised in your booking confirmation.

## Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider (Phone: 1800 372 737 or 07 4194 9300) 48 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, pick up location and time, and departure time with your confirmation number. Please adjust your travel plan according to the details given by The Service Provider at time of reconfirming.

## Check-in requirements

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the pick-up time at your booked pick up location. There might be 5-10 minutes delay depends on the traffic on the day. If you think the pick is late or you are not being picked up, please call The Service Provider and quote your confirmation number to double check.

## What to bring/wear

- Small overnight bag with personal towel & toiletries. No toothbrush, toothpaste, or slippers provided
- Appropriate clothing for all weather conditions, eg. jacket for cooler months.
- Comfortable shoes or sandals
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses
- Water bottle, Snacks
- Swimmers and towels
- Essential medication
- Umbrella / raincoat if rains

### Tour

- Tour itinerary may change due to tides and weather conditions.
- As this tour is off-road, Service Provider recommend that pregnant travellers or people with existing medical conditions seek medical advice before booking this tour.
- Travellers need to be independently mobile to access and disembark the 4WD buses and all tour sites visited.
- Foreign language guide app "Fraser Explorer Tours" is available in Chinese, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean and Spanish, and is available to download from Apple Store and Google Play Store.

### Accommodation:

- Twin/Double = two (2) people sharing a room.

### Porterage, Luggage Handling & Weight Policy:

- Due to Australian Workplace Health & Safety requirements, the maximum acceptable weight for any single piece of luggage is 25 kgs.
- Bags weighing 20+ kgs will be tagged with a fluoro tag to indicate heavy luggage and that care must be taken when handling.
- Each guest may check-in free of charge two (2) items of luggage each piece weighing no more than 20 kgs.
- Where guests are required to pack down luggage over 20 kgs, bags are available for sale from the Mainland Terminal.
- Additional items to be checked-in will incur a handling fee.
- Where guests will not pack down or are not happy to pay excess charges for luggage over 20 kgs, the guest will be asked to carry their own luggage at all transportation points: on and off boat/s; along jetty; to accommodation and repeat all procedures at departure time.

### Getting Here

- Fly via major capital cities to Hervey Bay airport (QANTAS + Virgin Australia operate flights daily).
- Transfer from Hervey Bay Airport to River Heads Terminal takes approximately 15 minutes .
- The cruise to Fraser Island takes approximately 45minutes across the Great Sandy Strait.

### Island Arrival

- Friendly Cool Dingo tour guide will greet you off the ferry, before join the group for the ultimate sunset experience along the western beach!
- Start tour off the Fraser Island way, with a complimentary welcome drink^ at The Sunset Bar and bask in that golden glow.
- Then it's time to check into the **Wilderness Lodges accommodation**^^ and enjoy a buffet dinner the Dingo Bar.

### About Wilderness Lodges

- Each lodge offers quad-share bedrooms (and some twin share) with full insect screens.

- Open lounge area for breakaway group activities, morning briefings or socialising,

## Day 2 Full Day 4WD Tour

---

### Highlights

- **75 Mile Beach** - Get ready to cruise the coastline, stretching as far as the eye can see, let's go!
- **Maheno Shipwreck** - enjoy a photo stop at the rusting wreck of the Maheno washed ashore during an out-of-season cyclone in 1935 - it's one of Fraser Island's most recognisable sites.
- **The Pinnacles Coloured Sands** - learn how these technicolour sand formations were created and the Butchulla legends surrounding them.
- **Champagne Pools** - Chill out in these aptly-named, bubbling rock pools, it's the No.1 swimming spot along the east coast!
- **Indian Head** - Ascend to the top of this rocky headland, for 360° views of Fraser, and keep a look out for sharks, rays, turtles and whales (July-October).
- **Eli Creek** - float down this fast-flowing freshwater creek pouring out 80 megalitres of water daily into the ocean.
- **Aussie bush tucker tasting** - YUM! Sample the flavours of Fraser, with this interactive Ranger-guided experience.

## Day 3 Depart Fraser Island

---

### Highlights

- **Lake McKenzie** - Paradise found! With pristine white sands and crystal-clear, turquoise hues, it's picture perfect!
- **Central Station / Wanggoolba Creek**- this former logging station that housed schools and shops for the bustling timber industry is now a tourist stop. Stroll along the Wanggoolba Creek boardwalk to discover the ancient King Ferns, towering Ghost Gums and Pine trees.
- **Lake Wabby / Hammerstone Sandblow** - Trek across the golden, desert-like sands and arrive at the hidden gem of Lake Wabby, an absolute emerald oasis.
- The tour will return to Wilderness Lodges in the late afternoon, in time for departure on the 5pm ferry back to River Heads (Courtesy drop-offs in Hervey Bay).
