How to get there

By Car

Christmas Cove Marina is located on Kangaroo Island, approximately 1km west of Penneshaw Ferry Terminal, takes about 4 minutes; approximately 52km east of Kingscote Airport, takes about 40 minutes; approximately 88km east of Seal Bay Conservation Park, takes about 1 hour 10 minutes.

- Parking is available in the carpark at Christmas Cove Marina
- By Ferry

Located approximately 20km south west of Cape Jervis Ferry Terminal, takes about 1 hour 10 minutes.

Christmas Cove Marina is 1km (approx.) from the Penneshaw Ferry Terminal, takes about 15 minutes walk.

• By Public Transport

Unfortunately there is no direct public transport available. Most visitors drive or arrive on a tour. If you do not drive, please book one of the day tours that visits Kangaroo Island with transfers.

Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, departure location and time, and boarding time with your confirmation number. Christmas Cove is one of Australia's Geological Monuments cut out by glacial movement 240 million years ago. It's the perfect place to start your marine wildlife safari. Dolphins and seals are only minutes away from the marina, which is the safest and easiest access marina on Kangaroo Island.

About Kangaroo Island

Matthew Flinders was the first European explorer to discover Kangaroo Island in 1802. He named it Kangaroo Island, because of the abundance of kangaroos he saw when he came to shore near Penneshaw. Come out on a Kangaroo Island Ocean Safari and you will be explained why Kangaroo Island has a coast line named in French and one in English and provide geological information on some of the oldest coastline on Kangaroo Island being approx 550 million years old.

Nicolas Baudin, who came to shore inscribed his details into "Frenchman's Rock" in Hog Bay, Penneshaw. You can see Frenchman's Rock as the cruise pass by in Penneshaw's sheltered waters on Kangaroo Island's favourite Ocean Safari. You will taken on a 75 minute coastal and wildlife tour around the beautiful coastline of Kangaroo Island, providing historical facts along the way.

You will be amazed when you see places like Dolphin Cove, Cuttlefish Bay, Kangaroo Head and Snapper Point. Kangaroo Island truly is one of the most desirable destinations for tourist travel and this Ocean Safari provides one of the most exceptional Kangaroo Island experiences.

Meet The Locals

Wild Dolphins

Encounter pods of Bottle Nose and Common Dolphins that can been seen up close. Enjoy them in their natural environment swimming up along side the boat, with numbers sometimes in the dozens. On many instances you'll see their baby calves.

• Fur Seals and Sea Lions

An abundance of New Zealand Fur Seals and Australian Sea Lions inhabit the coast that surrounds Kangaroo Island. These seals gather along the rocks enjoying the warm sun, resting after fishing for days on end and show off their agile swimming ability right before your eyes.

Whales

Witness Southern Right Whales (seasonal) as they pass through these waters on their annual migration to the Great Australian Bight. Humpback Whales (seasonal) travel through the waters off the Dudley Peninsula and can sometimes be seen on a Kangaroo Island Ocean Safari. Marvel at these magnificent giant mammals of the sea.

Sea Birds

There are many varieties of sea birds on the Safari including the unforgettable encounters with mighty Sea Eagles, Osprey and Wedge Tailed Eagles. Opportunities arise on this wildlife Safari to marvel at the eagle's diving into the ocean to grasp fish with their powerful talons. Cormorants and Gulls are abundant along the coast.
