Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, departure location and time, and boarding time with your confirmation number. Check-in requirements

Please arrive at the ticket office 30 minutes prior to the departure time to exchange for ticket/boarding pass before proceeding to the boarding terminal. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

- Winter (Jun-Aug) 4.54pm - 5.37pm
- Spring (Sep-Nov) 5.37pm - 7.51pm (note daylight savings time starts approx. October)
- Summer (Dec-Feb) 7.52pm - 7.33pm
- Autumn (Mar-May) 7.31pm - 4.54pm (note daylight savings time ends approx. April)
