The bus will pick you up at your city hotel for the start of the best of what Sydney has to offer. A half day seeing Sydney from the water and the other half the best Sydney has to offer by road. All done in privacy and luxury away from the tourist traps.

- 09:30 Bus departs from your hotel and commences the first portion of the land tour. This is a great introduction to the icons of Sydney where the tour starts appropriately from the birth place of Australia, The Rocks. Here you will learn about the settlement of Australia and the early days of life in Sydney. The tour weaves around the back streets of The Rocks, under the Harbour Bridge and on to Walsh Bay. This is the recently developed theatre district of Sydney.
- En route to The Botanic Gardens you will stop under the Harbour Bridge for a magnificent view back to The Sydney Opera House at Dawes Point.
