## How to get there

- By Car  
Located approximately 29km south-west of Perth Airport, takes about 45 minutes; approximately 19km south-west of Perth City, takes about 35 minutes; approximately 2km south-west of Fremantle, takes about 10 minutes.

Sardine Jetty is located within the Fishing Boat Harbour opposite the Fremantle Ferris Wheel.

## Check-in requirements

Please arrive at the ticket office 30 minutes prior to the departure time to exchange for ticket/boarding pass before proceeding to the boarding terminal. Regrettably, failure to arrive before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

## What to bring/wear

- Motion-sickness medicine (if required)
- Protective clothing, hat, sunscreen lotion, and sunglasses

- Light jacket / sweater for windy or cool days
- Camera
- Money / credit card for optional purchases

- Children and teenagers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Children are not permitted in the Captains Lounge without prior approval.
- Concession rates apply for valid concession card holders, Australian pensioner, current and Veteran Soldiers, Australian Emergency Service Personnel (Police, Fire, Ambulance) and disability card holders.

### SUGGESTED PREPARATION FOR TOUR

- It is suggested you bring warm clothing, wet weather gear for yourself and any camera gear, in warmer months sunscreen and a hat, if prone to motion sickness please take adequate medication as precaution. The Service Provider cannot provide sea sick tablets for insurance liability issues so please come prepared. Please be sure to arrive a minimum of 30 minutes prior to departure. Boarding commences 15 mins prior and gate is shut 5 mins prior to departure.

### WHEELCHAIRS

- Passengers in wheelchairs must notify the Service Provider at least 24 hours before tour departure so the crew can prepare the vessel and assist with boarding procedures.

### HEALTH PROBLEMS

- If you have mobility or health problems you must inform when booking. Passengers must follow the directions of the Service Provider's staff & crew before, during and after the tour. If you are accompanied by children you are responsible for their safety at all times.

\*PLEASE be sure to contact your Chemist prior to travel if you have any issue with motion sickness.

### RETURN VOUCHERS (NON SIGHTINGS)

- If a tour is canceled or postponed by the Service Provider due to inclement weather, or any other unforeseeable reason, including tour bookings made with a voucher, are non-refundable and must be rescheduled. A return ticket will be offered if your whale watch tour fails to sight the whale of your tour. All vouchers are non cash refundable.
- Should a tour be postponed for any reason by the Service Provider are non refundable and must be rescheduled.
- Customer is required to contact the Service Provider in writing via email and quote booking number to reschedule at available time. The return voucher is valid for one year from release. Transport/accommodation not included in return voucher for non sighting.
