

• Concession tickets- Australian Seniors Card, Australian Pensioners, full time students aged 16+. ID must be presented upon exchange for admissions.

• Child 5 to 15 years of age. Children under 5 years are free of charge. Children aged 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

• This tour is not wheelchair/pram accessible as this is a walking tour with 300+ steps.

• Opera House stages lots of live performances, so venues are subject to availability at the time of your tour.

• Opera House can't store suitcases or large bags. Bags larger than A4 size will need to be cloaked before you can go on the tour.

Videoing is not allowed.

• There are plenty of photo opportunities - your tour guide will advise you if photos are not to be taken at any point.

• Mobile phones are permitted on the tour however please ensure they are switched off or on silent for the duration of the tour.
