How to get there

【Aquarium Wharf】

- By Public Transport

Aquarium Wharf, Darling Harbour is a 10-minute walk from Wynyard station or 15min from Pymont Light Rail station.

From Wynyard you can traipse from Clarence Street along the Wynyard Walk, a new state-of-the-art, fully accessible underground pedestrian link through the city. Emerge at Barangaroo and enjoy a walk along the water to Aquarium Wharf.

- By Car

Sun Parking is located at 261-293 Kent St in the basement levels of Westpac Tower, and is only a two-minute walk along Erskine Street from Aquarium Wharf. There are entrances on Sussex Street and Kent Street.

- Wilson Parking - Gateway (Address: 155 George St, The Rocks NSW 2000), approximately 3 minutes walk.
- Enacon Parking (Address: 117 Macquarie St, Sydney NSW 2000), approximately 7 minutes walk.

Reconfirmation requirements

Please be advised you are required to contact The Service Provider 24 hours prior to the travel date during business hours to reconfirm your booking, departure location and time, and boarding time with your confirmation number. Please adjust your travel plan according to the details given by The Service Provider at time of reconfirming.

Check-in requirements

Please arrive at the ticket office 30 minutes prior to the departure time to exchange for ticket/boarding pass before proceeding to the boarding terminal. Regrettably, failure to arrive

before this time will most likely be classified as no-show and result in forfeiting the booking and it cannot be refunded or transferred.

If you are not familiar with the area or travelling on a weekend or local public holidays / school holidays, please make sure you've checked your timetable or driving route beforehand, and allow extra travelling time for unexpected delays to ensure you do not miss your check in

What to bring/wear

- Comfortable shoes
- Light jacket/sweater for windy or cool days
- Camera (waterproof)
- Credit card for optional purchases

- Drinks and snacks are available for purchase from friendly crews at the on board bar (please note the bar is cashless, card payments only)
- Smoking is not permitted aboard the vessel.
- No alcohol is to be brought onto the vessel.
- Passengers must not bring any illegal substances onto the vessel.
- The Service Provider adheres to the laws governing the Responsible Service of Alcohol. Alcohol will not be served to any passenger under the age of 18. Bar staff may request identification for proof of age. Service of alcohol will be refused if the passenger fails to provide identification as requested.
- Bar staff are trained in the responsible service of alcohol. Service of alcohol will be refused to any passenger who, in the opinion of the bar staff, is intoxicated.
- It is in the discretion of the bar staff/crew/Master of the vessel to refuse alcohol to any passenger for any reason.
- Alcohol will only be served in accordance with the times specified on our on-premise liquor licence for the vessel.

[Important Post-Covid Service Information]

- Guests aged 16 years and older must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. Upon entry all guests must provide proof of Covid-19 vaccination or medical exemption documentation. Guests aged 16 years and older, unable to provide the vaccination or medical exemption documentation will be refused entry and no refund will be offered as the consequence.
