How to get there

By Car

Peninsula Hot Springs is on the Mornington Peninsula, it takes approximately 90 minutes by car from Melbourne.

- If traveling from Melbourne, board a Frankston line train to Frankston, then take the No.788 bus to Rye hotel where can catch an uber or taxi service. Alternatively can walk from Rye which takes approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes, please take care when walking as it is along a busy road with a high speed limit.

Check-in requirements

- BYO Glassware and alcohol is not permitted at Peninsula Hot Springs.
- Please shower before entering the pools.
- Smoking, alcohol and glassware are not permitted in the bathing areas.
- Guests under the influence of alcohol or drugs may be refused to partake in their booking.
- Please be mindful when you take photos of other guests comfort and privacy around you. It is only allowed to take photos of your group, your immediate family, and your friends, whilst bathing.
- When bathing in the hot pools please take breaks every 15 minutes and drink water regularly.
